Furnace Care 101

A furnace needs a little attention to run without failing you. The harder it works, the more important your attention is.

- 1. Change or clean your furnace filters monthly. Dust build-up will increase your electricity costs for fan operation.
- 2. Remove clutter from around the furnace. Combustibles are a fire hazard!
- 3. Keep an eye on your roof, or wherever your furnace vents are, when it starts to snow. Make sure the vents and intake pipes are free of snow or ice build-up. Without adequate air and venting, your furnace will stop, just when you need it most. When snow is forecast, check those vents.

- 4. Check the color of your furnace's flame. It should be blue with touches of orange. If it is yellowish, your furnace is burning inefficiently and wasting money. A professional should correct this for you.
- 5. Look for corrosion, especially around the flame or flue. You may need replacement parts and a tune -up.
- 6. As a rule of thumb, have your furnace cleaned and tuned every other year by a professional to extend its life.
